

Montpelier Roxbury Public Schools- Food Service

Daily meal bags will consist of a lunch and a breakfast for the next day. The meals will be based on the school lunch meal pattern and will be prepared in our safe and sanitary MHS kitchen.

Meals are provided at no cost to any student through a special dispensation of the Summer Food Service Program. No application or approval is needed.

Meal pick ups will occur at Montpelier High School, from the side service entrance, from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm Monday-Friday. There will be signs telling families where to go.

Meal pick ups will occur at Roxbury Village School, near the front entrance, from 12:30 pm to 1:00 pm Monday-Friday.

Our plan is flexible. Times, places, and other details are subject to change as needed

A key priority for OESU is continuing to feed our students and families. Details on how that is being accomplished are being sent out to families from their schools or the OESU office. Please note, that these meals will be free to all children ages 1 to 18 in eligible school communities (**Bradford, Newbury, Oxbow, Waits River, and Blue Mountain**). 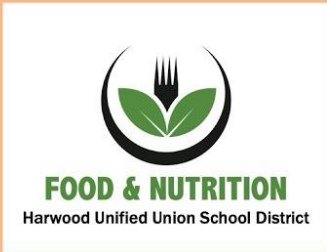

Procedures:

- 1- Please fill out our google form so we can estimate how many meals to make. If you don't have internet access please call 802-583-8022 to place an order. An order is not mandatory, but appreciated. We don't want to run out of meals.
- 2- Drive or walk to a pick up site. Children do not need to be present. Let volunteers know many children you need meals for, no questions asked.
- 3- Children do not need to be enrolled at HUUSD. All children will be fed as long as they are 18 and under.
- 4- All meals are prepared by our culinary team at Harwood High School.
